Worship Notes

Oh what a Savior! Isn't He wonderful!
Sing Hallelujah, Christ is risen!

The word Hallelujah is such an amazing word. We sing it, we shout it, we proclaim it, but do we know what it means? I mean do we really know what this word means? It is actually a two part word with "hallelu" meaning to praise and "Jah" or "Yah" as the very name of God. Hallelujah means praise God, or literally "praise the Lord."

Some have tried to misuse this word for their own devices and have denied the power that comes in praising God. The Bible tells us that praise is how we enter into the inner courts of God, literally into His Presence. How differently would the praise that you bring to God look if you praised Him with your whole heart? If you approached worship with not just the idea, but the true, heart knowledge that you were about to enter into the Presence of God? Would you approach worship in a different way? What if you entered into His Presence each day through the door of praise and thanksgiving? How differently would our "worship services" be if the Presence of God, the Breath of God's Holy Spirit, came alive in our hearts as we came together to worship Jesus?

Something I learned a long time ago is this: we all actively worship something in our lives. For some it is your job, or your music. For some it is your hobbies, or vacations, or a house, a boat, or a car. For some it is money. For some it is your family. We all worship something, but there is only One who is worthy of all our worship, and anything else we give all of our love to is an idol. An Almighty God, who is sovereign over all should not and will not share His Worship with anything or anyone else. That is why Jesus says in John 4 that the Father is seeking those who will wholeheartedly worship Him in Spirit and in Truth. Truly look into your heart and ask the question, what am I worshipping?
