July Missions News

Allied Churches of Alamance County published some 2020 Highlights on Housing the Homeless and Feeding the Hungry:

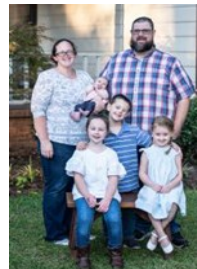
- ◆ Over 65,000 lbs. of food provided (including 450 boxes for 8 weeks to help during COVID-19)
- ◆ 150-200 meals/day served at Joe's Diner (their cafeteria)
- ◆ \$50,000 in financial assistance provided with approx. \$1100-\$1400 financial assistance provided per individual/family housed
- ◆ 87% success rate from shelter to permanent housing
- ◆ 86% of residents secured employment within 14 days of being admitted

Central India Christian Mission (CICM) India's government reports over 307,000 deaths from COVID 19; 30 million have been infected, with only 4% of the people fully vaccinated. Because of lockdown millions have lost jobs and are without food and income, since they rely on what they earn each day. CICM has opened up 38 relief centers in 11 states to distribute food, medicine including vaccinations, and oxygen. Ajai Lall thanks us for our support that allows them to meet the needs head-on and be light and salt to the world rather than run from it.



Mid Atlantic Christian University (MACU) President John Maurice will be coming to BCC Sunday August 1st to preach and update us on the work there. They have already begun construction on the 1st phase of the rebuilding project, the Cafeteria. Phase 2 will replace the collapsed Heritage Hall. For more info: www.macuniversity.edu

Hey church family,

It is so good to be back! Praise God for the wonderful works He is doing, and I am so thankful for the prayers and support you have shown during my time over in Uganda! It was such a blessing to have a front row seat at the working of God's hands! From salvation, discipleship, crusades, training worship leaders, building community... God had intentional purposes that were bigger than what I could have planned. In my time there, the Lord encouraged my heart that He delights when His children take steps of faith and that His timing is perfect. (Romans 8:28, Psalm 37:23, Ephesians 2:10, Psalm 31:15)

The following scripture God brought to mind in times of prayer and speaking His truth. Philippians 4:6-7 says "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

Here are some ways that you can partner in praying for the ministry and people of Uganda:

1. COVID: The country is in lockdown due to rising cases. This is causing a crisis of mental and spiritual health as well as a decline in the economy. We trust that what Satan would intend for evil, God uses for our good (Genesis 50:20, Jeremiah 29:11). Please join in prayer that God would use this season to strengthen His people, bring sons and daughters to Him, and help us to hunger and thirst after His righteousness.

2. Ministries: **Ignite Change** and **PAG** (Pentecostal Assemblies of God) are two ministries I partnered with during my time in Uganda. Here are the pro-

jects that have been postponed due to COVID:

(a) **Ignite Change** is working on a project for single moms to equip them with sewing skills so that they can have a sustainable income.

(b) **PAG** is working on discipleship training for church leaders to equip them to lead their congregations. Please pray for wisdom for the leaders, for continued spiritual growth, and for God to be glorified.

3. The following are specific people the Lord connected me with in Kamdini. Please join me in prayer that they will press into Christ as their strength, rest in His goodness, and that the Lord will provide for their every need.

K - Single mom of four children. She has just started a business. Please pray that God would bless her efforts and provide food and education for her children. (In Uganda, parents are required to pay for any education their children receive)

A - He is a teacher who is looking for work. Satan has brought many oppressions in His life. Please pray that he will choose to celebrate the joy of the Lord and experience a fresh taste of the overwhelming love of God.

E - He is an agricultural and animal specialist. His employer has not paid him over the past two months. Please pray that he will trust in God's goodness and that the Lord would lead Him where God wants him to go.

Thank you for your continued support and prayers. I look forward to sharing more with you in the future, and I celebrate this sweet opportunity of worshipping together!

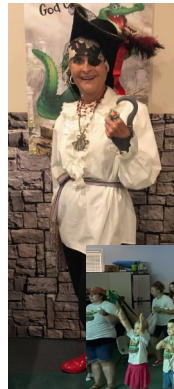
Women’s Bible Studies
